- Meet the attendance policy requirements

### **Grades 2-5 Guidelines**

- Have a final grade of 70 or higher in ELA, Reading, Math, Social Studies, and Science
- Meet the attendance policy requirements
- See assessment targets on RIT Scores in chart below

### Grades 6-8 Guidelines

- Have a final grade of 70 or higher in ELA, Math, Social Studies and Science
- Have a final grade of 70 or higher in 75% of the total number of connections coursestaken
- Meet the attendance policy requirements
- See assessment targets on RIT Scores in chart below

### Assessment Guidelines - Grades 2 - 8

These assessments are **NOT** the sole criteria in determining promotion/retention. Elementary and middle school principals will use multiple measures in determining final student promotion decisions. Special provisions may be made for students who are English Language Learners and students with identified disabilities.
